




6. "Infrastructure facilities in container terminal" to be added in Container Management.
7. Suggestion to add integrated 3PL, 4PL and 5PL, Drone Logistics and Delivery applications in International Logistics Management.
8. Suggested to remove R' Data mining and insisted to mention Data mining using advanced Statistical tools.

1. Suggested to remove Project Management while retain only Entrepreneurship Development course for more relevance to the course.
2. Recommended to include in Export and Import documentation and recommended to remove Foreign Trade Policy from the same.
3. To remove "MRTP Act" and suggested to add "Consumer Protection Act 1986" from Economics for Executive paper.
4. Suggested to add types of port while removing types of International ships from shipping and packaging course.
5. Recommended to add role of regional integration (SAAR, G7 and BRICS), and also elevate pricing strategies to International standards.
6. The word "emerging technology" can be removed in Container management.
7. Recommended to remove "Aircraft Manufactures" and to add "Currency regulation" in Air Cargo Management.
