### Public Awareness Rally

**Date: 26.07.2019**

The Department of Microbiology of Hindusthan College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore conducted an awareness programme on Hepatitis. To commemorate the World Hepatitis Day, students of the department created public awareness by marching on a Rally from Women's Polytechnic to VOC Ground on 26.07.2019. The rally was flagged off by Dr. A. Ponnusamy, Principal, Hindusthan College of Arts and Science. The students of the Microbiology department carried placards with phrases about the disease Hepatitis. World Hepatitis Day is celebrated on 28<sup>th</sup> July of every year. The theme as per the World Health Organization this year is “**Invest in Eliminating Hepatitis: Find the Missing Millions**”.

Viral hepatitis is the second major killer infectious disease after tuberculosis, and 9 times more people are infected with hepatitis than HIV. Thus it is necessary to create awareness about the disease **Hepatitis that is preventable, treatable and curable. Around 300 students participated.**
