The state has conducted 15 assembly elections and 16 Lok Sabha elections since dependence. The sixteenth legislative assembly election is to be held on 6 April 2021 to elect members from 234 constituencies of the Legislative Assembly in the state of Tamil Nadu in India.

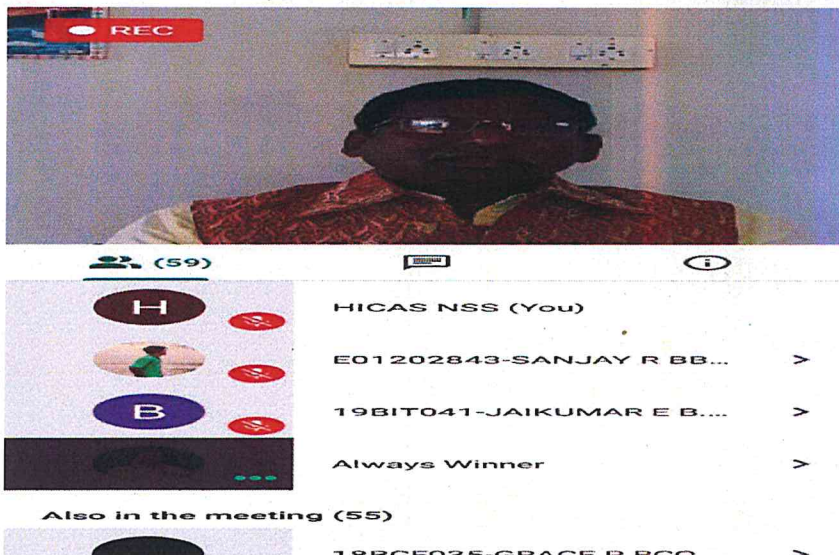

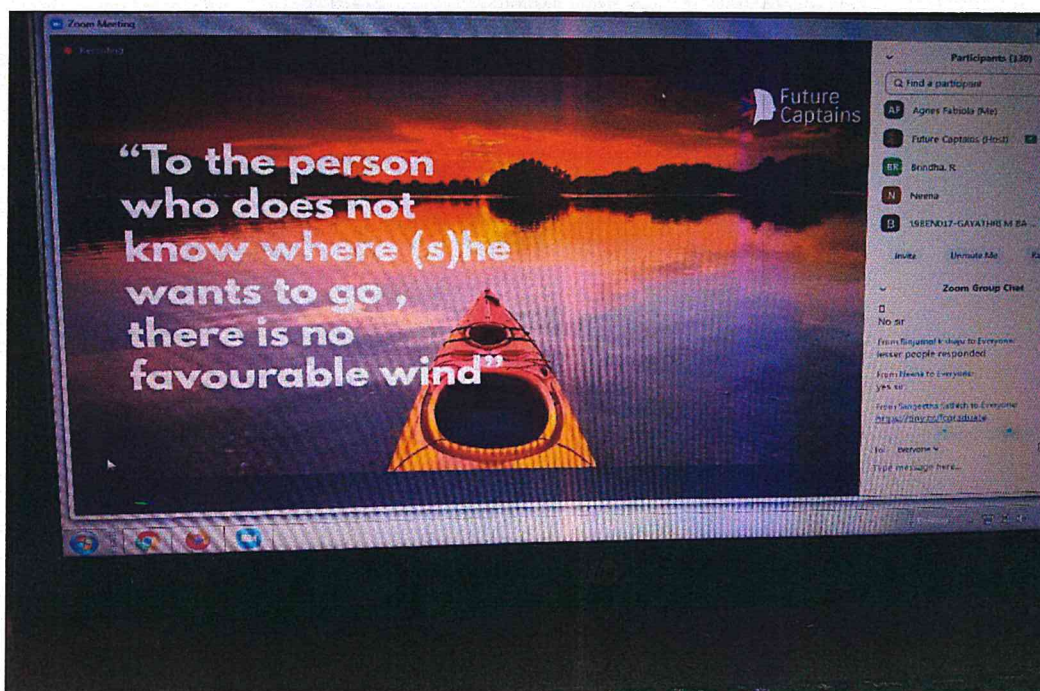
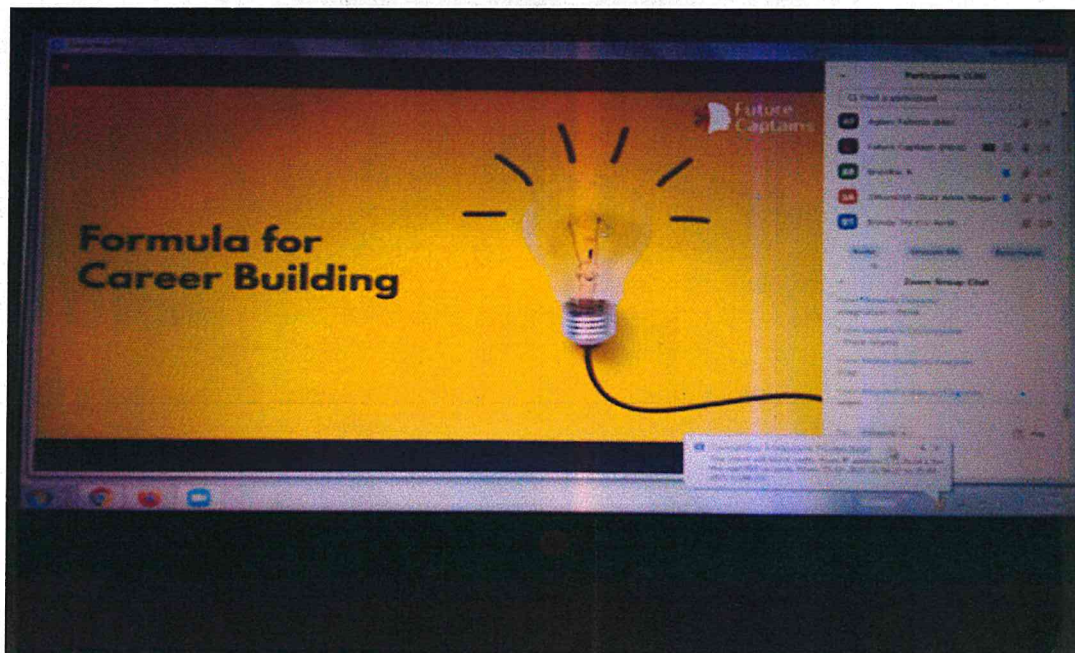

Report on Career Planning Process

The corona pandemic which has influenced the lives of many universally in both positive and negative ways has definitely thrown lot of challenges in the employment sector. In order to encourage the student community to move in the right direction, Department of Social Work along with National Service Scheme and the Youth Red Cross of Hindusthan College of Arts and Science planned to hold an online Webinar on Career planning process. This was coordinated with Future Captains an independent Organization that helps school and College students plan

their career. The session was held on 25th January 2021 through Zoom meet from 11 am to 12.30 pm and was attended by 166 participants including 12 faculty members.

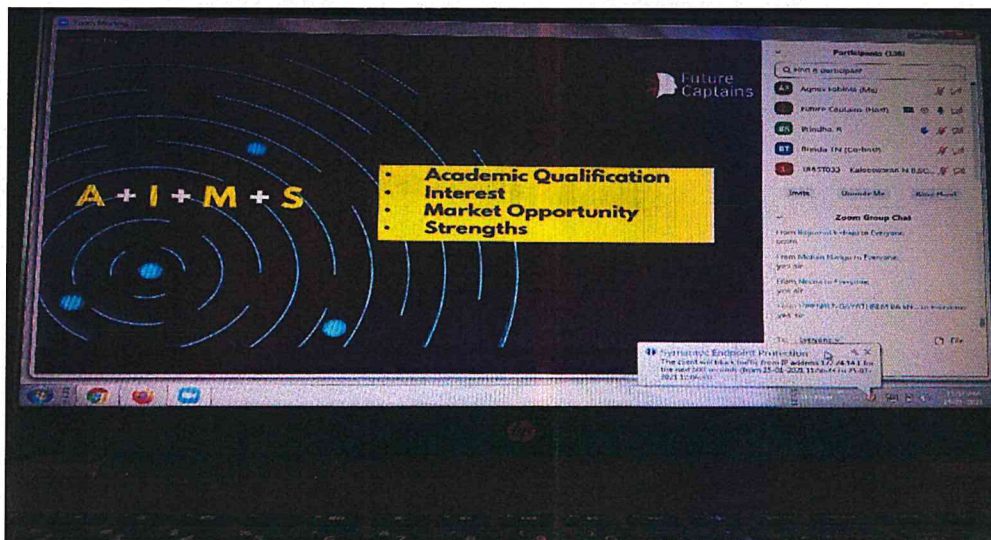


When we say employment it is a job. The difference between a job and a career is... job is like eating just curd rice, whereas career is like eating full meals. A job is just going to feed

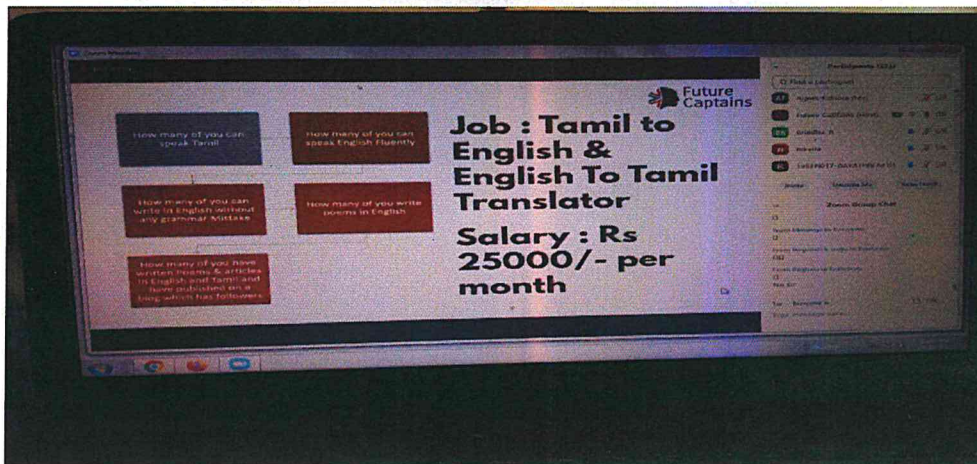
you. Majority are told to find a job than to build a career. No one really tells you what the job market is looking in you. Speed and accuracy are important.

He shared about how he made choices in his life. He said he failed several times as he did not make right choices or move in the right direction. Though he was working in several IT companies with good salaries, he didn't find meaning in them. He stated that if he had not left those companies, he would have started feeling comfortable and would have got trapped forever. "That was the reason I pulled out of Call centre", he stated.

He further stated that you need to be clear about what the job market is looking for. He was explaining about; Speed Vs Accuracy Vs Velocity. Velocity is even more important...i.e in what direction you move is what defines you.



The resource person highlighted on transferable and non-transferable skills and explained about them. He stated about AIMS. Academic qualification, Interest of the candidate, market opportunity and the strengths of an individual leads to the success of a person.



When a person has the needed academic qualification, and also has the interest and willingness to perform and which is also required by the job market, that becomes the strength of the individual in fetching him the right opportunity and enables him or her to move in the right direction.

He delivered his session in a very thought provoking manner that the students were found to be inspired and were alert and some of them were found to be constantly responding in the chat box to the questions asked by the resource person. He shared about the vision of Future Captains and promised to assist students to help them think and make right choices. The students clarified doubts and thanked for opening their eyes to deeper learning.
